Merry Munchers was formed due to overwhelming interest as a small group ministry for members of First Presbyterian Church of Bozeman to share food, fellowship, and fun once a month in homes of volunteer hosts. The following Etiquette Guidelines were developed to help foster the positive development of personal relationships within our congregation. Please consider these guidelines when you host and when you are a guest in this exciting ministry!

Guests:

- These gatherings are intended for adults unless specifically noted otherwise by your hosts.
- If you are single and want to bring a guest, please ask early in the week.
- Make sure you know what food item you are assigned to bring and stick to your assignment so the meal is complete.
- Plan to bring enough of your dish to feed the number of guests expected.
- Be punctual.
- Offer to help clean up after the meal.
- If you have food allergies, contact your hosts well in advance of the meal.
- If you must cancel, please give your hosts as much notice as possible, and work with them to find a substitute.
- As always, "Please" and "Thank you" are appreciated.

Hosts:

- Call your guests early in the week to discuss the menu.
- If you need to change the date from the third Friday of the month, please give your guests enough warning to accommodate their schedules.
- Arrange rides for your guests if needed.
- Please consider any special needs of your guests.
- If a guest has a food allergies, please inform others who are bringing food.
- When calling singles, invite them to bring a guest.
- If your residence is difficult to find, please provide adequate directions and/or a map.
- If you intend to serve alcohol at your home, be sensitive to those who don't drink and have other beverages available.
